



Dear Valued Patient,

All of us at Atlanta Center for Advanced Periodontics, Cosmetic & Implant Dentistry are wishing you good health. At this time, we want to inform you that our practice will be taking our first steps towards resuming a normal schedule beginning Monday, May 4th. We will be modifying our schedule to include routine periodontal maintenance appointments, selective procedures, consultations and emergency care. We will be altering the number of scheduled appointments to limit the amount of traffic in and out of the office. We are following directives from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Georgia Dental Association (GDA), as well as the American Dental Association (ADA) to limit patient and staff exposure to the Novel Coronavirus. We are resilient in our dedication to your overall health. The safety of our employees, patients, and doctors is paramount, and we believe the best strategy to protect our community from unnecessary risk is to exercise caution.

As the gravity of the COVID-19 virus has become clear, **we are implementing precautionary measures above and beyond the standard procedures strictly to protect the health and safety of our patients and employees.** These procedures include:

- Screening patients and visitors for fever, recent travel history, and signs or symptoms of infection prior to appointments
- Pre-rising patients with Peridex, a medical grade mouthwash, for one minute at the start of appointments to reduce the salivary load of oral microbes
- Implementing a strict hand washing rule upon arrival to the office
- Thoroughly disinfecting the waiting room and treatment rooms after patient visits as well as high touch areas, such as doorknobs
- Removing magazines from waiting areas
- We will allow patients to wait for appointments in the car after checking in
- We will be happy to text and/or call to notify you when we are ready to begin treatment
- New air purifying systems in the patient treatment rooms that filter .003microns
- Continuing to provide Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) to our employees including N95 masks, face shields and disposable gowns

We ask that when you check-in you:

- Inform us if you are experiencing cold or flu-like symptoms, have an existing lung condition or immunodeficiency, or have traveled to Asia or Europe during the last month; and
- Take advantage of hand washing and hand sanitizer at our office
